

Belgrave rejects site for luxury hotel

A permit to build a luxury hotel at Micawber Park on Monbulk rd. has been refused by the Belgrave shire council.

Cr. G. E. Handasyde, former council president, said the application had been refused for safety reasons.

The council believed a

hotel on this site might provide a danger to motorists because it would need a large parking area to serve the hotel.

A big residential hotel, with sporting facilities to attract overseas tourists, was understood to be the promoters' aim.
